

Quality and Environmental Policy

Policy statement and scope

Stalatable is committed to being trustworthy and value-adding partner for both society and our entire cooperation network, whose requirements and expectations we recognize. Our operations are based on trust, respect and honesty.

This policy applies to all employees, partners and members of our value chain.

Commitments and principles

We are committed to complying with country-specific laws and regulations at all of our locations. We operate in accordance with the quality and environmental standards ISO9001 and ISO14001 certificates granted to us and deliver our products in accordance with all declared requirements and applicable standards.

Sustainability

We systematically strive to identify and mitigate our negative impact on the environment around us, including minimizing clean water consumption, air pollution prevention, tracking our Scope 1-3 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions and employing responsible chemical use. We have set near-term and long-term emission reduction targets to align with the Paris Agreement's goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C and the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi).

Near-term

Stalatable Oy targets to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 42 % by 2030 from a 2021 base year. Stalatable Oy also targets to reduce scope 3 GHG emissions 52 % per tonne of production within the same timeframe.

Long-term

Stalatable Oy targets to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 90 % by 2050 from a 2021 base year. Stalatable Oy also targets to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions 90 % within the same timeframe.

In order to achieve our emission reduction targets, we use raw material, 75 % of which at minimum is recycled material, and we aim to increase its share even further by promoting the stainless steel circularity. We will improve our energy efficiency and increase the share of fossil free energy sources. We will focus on material use efficiency and return all of the stainless steel scrap to circulation. We will manage the use of hazardous materials in order to substitute them with less harmful alternatives and dispose of them in a responsible manner. We demand the same responsibility and values from both our suppliers and our other partners. We are committed to communicating our environmental impact and the achievement of our environmental goals on an annual basis.

Environmental advocacy and carbon handprint

We promote our environmental advocacy and strive to increase our positive carbon handprint by enabling our partners to significantly lower their carbon footprint. We do this by supplying our customers the lowest CO₂e-factor products on the market, verified by carbon footprint calculations and Environmental Product Declarations, as well as offering our expertise in material specification to achieve the most optimal structures in terms of material and resource use. We work to promote knowledge in subjects like Lifecycle emissions, end-of-life recycling and lower overall emission alternatives.
